**Scholarship Eligibility and Guidelines:**

1. Must be of African-American heritage and identity.
2. Must be a graduating high school senior or continuing college student attending Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University, University of Arizona or a Maricopa Community College. Out of state (Arizona) colleges are exceptions, but will be considered.
3. Must be enrolled in a minimum of twelve (12) credit hours during the semester of the scholarship award.
4. Must have a cumulative 2.0 GPA or higher (High School or College).
5. Scholarship application and supporting documents must be submitted or postmarked no later than **March 15, 2018**.
6. **Winners must attend the Award Ceremony on April 20, 2018.**

**Application Process:**

- Scholarship applicants must complete the attached application form and submit supporting materials as described not later than **March 15, 2018**.
- Winners will need to be present at the NAACP Freedom Fund Dinner on **Friday, April 20, 2018** for recognition and celebration of scholarship recipients.

**NOTE:** Based upon review of the information submitted (student applications, personal statements, transcripts, and letters of recommendation), decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final. Scholarship awards may range from \$1,000.00 to \$2,500.00.

1. Transcript (Unofficial)

Applicants must submit an unofficial transcript from your high school or college with the application.

2. Personal Statement (Must be typed or word-processed)

Applicants must submit a personal statement between 1,000 – 2,000 words that provides the following information:

- a. Career Goals
- b. Academic Accomplishments
- c. Honors/Awards
- d. Ethnic Heritage
- e. Community and School Involvement
- f. Financial Need

Conclude your personal statement by answering the following statement:

*If awarded this prestigious scholarship, I will advance the mission of the NAACP by....*

3. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation

Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation from instructors, employers, or clergy (as examples).

Letters from friends or family are **not** appropriate.

Please do **not** send a resume.

**All supporting documents must be submitted with the application!**
